Driver, Team and Volunteers Information 2016/2017 Season

Welcome to a new Speedway Season at Baypark Family Speedway.

Due to new Health and Safety requirements of both Bay Venues and Speedway New Zealand, we have had to set some new rules whilst at an event at Baypark. Some of what follows has been a requirement for many seasons but has been ignored by some, however this year these rules will be enforced.

- The driver is responsible for all crew – whether they actively work on the car or are just part of the larger family
- The pit area is strictly no smoking – anyone found breaking this rule will be excluded from the pits for the remainder of that event (their pit access armband will be removed)
- All fuel must be carried in approved fuel containers
- Each team must have a fire extinguisher in their Pit Equipment and present this extinguisher for inspection at Green Sheeting
- The pit area is strictly no alcohol – Bay Venues Liquor License now covers the entire facility and failure to respect this will cause issues.
- The Pit area will be closed to all public from 6.30pm until after the cars from the last race of the evening have returned to the Pits.
- Each race car entered will be allowed to have the driver and 4 crew in the pits between the above times.
- Each driver will be issued with 4 arm bands that must be worn by their crew – No Arm Band No Entry to the Pits
- All Crew must have covered in footwear
- Nylon Clothing is banned
- No one under 16 years of age are allowed in the pits during racing unless they are a Mini Stock Competitor or crew for one of the Race Teams present.
- At all times any child under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult in the Pit Area.
- When operating a quad bike either in the pits or on the race track a suitable helmet must be worn at all times.
- A speed limit of 15kph must be observed in the pit area at all times
- All competitors and crew must respect and obey the instructions of the Promoter, Clerk of the Course, SNZ Officials and/or Speedway Volunteers at all times whilst on the grounds of Baypark Family Speedway. Failure to comply will result in immediate removal from the venue, possible further exclusions and/or fines
