Entries Close 15th January 2019 and will be limited to the first 180 received

Conditions of Entry:

- Pit Gates open at 10.00am
- The driver will be admitted free with each race car competing at this event.
- Ticket prices are (per night) – Adults (16 and over) \$30, Children (5 to 15 years old) \$10, Children (under 5) free, Senior Citizens (NZ Gold Card Holders) \$10, Family (2 adults & 3 children) \$70.00

Rules:

- This event will be run according to the Speedway New Zealand rule book
- Noise - No vehicle shall exceed 95 dba
- All drivers must wear race receivers.
- Sponsors advertising may be affixed on each car – in a reasonable position and without compromising existing signage, failure to comply will result in disqualification.

Entries

- An entry will only be accepted once the \$50.00 entry fee has been received by the promoter, prior to the date that the entries close.
- Late entries may be accepted at the Promoters discretion, provided the 180 entry limit has not been reached. There will be a \$150 charge with each late entry.
- All non Baypark entries must be accompanied with a track clearance

Scrutineering:

- Scrutineering will commence at 10.00am on both days and conclude at 3.00pm
- Scrutineering will be done in heat groups as directed

Technical Inspections:

- Please pay attention to rules E2-3-1 to E2-3-5

Practise:

- There will be a practise for all entrants on Thursday 14th February commencing at 4.00pm and concluding at 6.00pm.
- The pits will open at mid-day – entry will be free.
- Cars will be run in groups of 30 as they present on the dummy grid
- Each group will have 6 laps – if there is a stoppage within the 6 laps, that practise will be deemed complete

Racing:

- Commences at 6.30pm and concludes at 10.00pm.
- All competitors will be required to pay a \$10 fee towards Medical First Responder costs when signing in on Friday

Driver Profile:

- Entries will not be accepted without a legible and complete driver profile, once your entry has been received you may be required to provide a colour picture of your car.

Race Format:

- Drivers will be split into five (5) groups. These will be seeded by the Promoter.
- Each group will race in three (3) heats of twelve (12) laps each on Friday.
- Grid positions on Friday for heat one (1) will be marble draw on Thursday night in the clubrooms, the other two (2) heats will rotate to achieve front, middle & back starting positions. Points will be awarded from 36 points for 1st place, to 1 point for 36 position.

Friday – 15 Races

3 heats per group

Saturday – 10 Races

1 x Repechage, Division 2 (7 highest points from each group which did not make Championship) x 3 heats, Division 3 (8 highest points from each group which did not make Division 2) x 3 heats, Championship x 3 heats

- The top six (6) point's scorers in each group will qualify directly to the 3 x Championship heats of fifteen (15) laps.
- If two or more competitors are on the same points the competitor with the highest finishing position in Heat 1 will prevail, if they are still equal then then the same will apply in Heat 2.
- The next seven (7) drivers from each Group will compete in one repechage of twelve (12) laps. The makeup of this repechage will be based on points.
- The first 6 cars to cross the finish line in the repechage will progress to the New Zealand Championship finals heats.
- Grid positions for the first Championship heat will be by marble draw on Friday night in the Clubrooms and then follow Speedway New Zealand Rule M4-32-7, accepting that there will be 36 cars.

The driver with the most points after 3 Championship Heats will be the New Zealand Stock Car Champion for 2018/2019

Lap Scoring:

- As per Speedway NZ Rules and Regulations – Clause E4-4-5. It is the competitor's responsibility to make sure that their transmitter is fitted to the vehicle in the correct position and charged always when the Dorian Data-1 is in use. Vehicles without a transmitter will not be permitted to race.
