**Conditions of Entry:**

- Pit Gates open at 3.00pm
- The driver will be admitted free with each race car competing at this event.
- Ticket prices are – Adults (16 and over) \$25, Children (5 to 15 years old) \$10, Children (under 5) free, Senior Citizens (NZ Gold Card Holders) \$10, Family (2 adults & 3 children) \$60.00

**Rules:**

- This event will be run according to the Speedway New Zealand rule book
- Noise - No vehicle shall exceed 95 dba
- All drivers to wear race receivers
- Sponsors advertising may be affixed on each car – in a reasonable position.

**Entries**

- Late entries may be accepted. There will be a \$50 charge with each late entry.
- All non Baypark entries must be accompanied with a track clearance

**Scrutineering:**

- Scrutineering will commence at 12.00pm (*mid-day*) and conclude at 3.00pm at a place to be confirmed

**Technical Inspections:**

- Please pay attention to rules E2-3-1 to E2-3-5

**Practise:**

- Entrants will be split into two (2) groups for a ten (10) lap practise prior to racing commencing

**Racing:**

- Commences at 6.30pm and concludes at 10.00pm.

**Driver Profile:**

- Entries will not be accepted without a legible and complete driver profile

**Race Format:**

- Drivers will be split into six (6) groups. These will be seeded by the Promoter.

- Each group will race in three (3) heats of ten (10) laps each on Friday and two (2) heats of ten (10) laps on Saturday night
- Grid positions on Friday for heat one (1) will be marble draw, the other two (2) heats will rotate to achieve front, middle & back starting positions. Points will be awarded from 15 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 13 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 12 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> and so on down.

**Heat 1**   **Red - Blue**  
**Green – White**  
**Yellow – Pink**

**Heat 2**   **Red – Green**  
**Blue – Pink**  
**Yellow – White**

**Heat 3**   **Blue - Green**  
**Red - Yellow**  
**White - Pink**

- Grid positions for Saturday nights heats will be

**Heat 4**   **Blue - Yellow**  
**Red – White**  
**Green – Pink**

**Heat 5**   **Blue – White**  
**Green – Yellow**  
**Red – Pink**

- The top twenty-four (24) point's scorers from all entries will qualify for the final race of thirty (30) laps.
- The highest points from the heats will determine grid positions for the Feature Event. From Grid 1 to grid 24. If two or more competitors are on the same points the competitor with a win in Heat 1 will prevail, if they are still equal then then whoever has a win in Heat 2 and so on.
- All remaining drivers will compete in one of two (2) repechage of ten (10) laps. The makeup of these two (2) repechage will be based on points. Whoever is 25<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> & so on in points will be in Repechage A and whoever is 22<sup>nd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup> & so on in points will be in repechage B
- The first three (3) finishers of each repechage will qualify for the final race and fill grid positions 25 to 30. First repechage grid positions in finishing order will take up grid positions 25, 27 and 29. Second repechage grid positions in finishing order will take up grid positions 26, 28 and 30.

**The first driver across the finish line after thirty (30) laps will be the New Zealand Super Saloon Champion for 2017/2018**

### Lap Scoring:

- As per Speedway NZ Rules and Regulations – Clause E4-4-5. It is the competitor's responsibility to make sure that their transmitter is fitted to the vehicle in the correct position and charged always when the Dorian Data-1 is in use. Vehicles without a transmitter will not be permitted to race.
