- Pit Gates open at 3.00pm
Ticket prices are – Family (2 Adults & 3 Children) \$60, Adults (16 and over) \$25, Children (5 to 15 years old) \$10, Senior Citizens (NZ Gold Card Holders) \$10, Children (under 5) free,

Rules:

- This event will be run according to the Speedway New Zealand rule book
- Noise - No vehicle shall exceed 95 dba

Scrutineering:

- Scrutineering will commence at 3.00pm and conclude at 5.30pm

Drivers Briefing:

- Will commence in the Clubrooms at 5.30pm
- All drivers (and only drivers) must attend
- All drivers to wear race receivers
- Sponsors advertising may be affixed on each car – in a reasonable position.

Entries

- Late entries may be accepted.
- All non Baypark entries must be accompanied with a track clearance

Racing:

Commences at 6.30pm and concludes at 10.00pm. If for unforeseen reasons the South Pacific Super Saloon Title Race has not run its full number of laps within the curfew, the race will be declared complete at the Promoters discretion.

Race Format:

- There will be two (2) heats of twelve (12) laps each
- Grid positions for heat one (1) will be marble draw. Grid positions for heat two (2) will be reverse of heat one (1).
- Points will be awarded from 20 points for 1st place, 18 points for 2nd place, 17 points for 3rd and so on down

- The driver with the highest points after the two heats will start the feature race on the front row in the position of their choice. The balance of the starting grid will be made up by highest points at the front down to least points at the rear of the grid.

The first driver across the finish line after Twenty-Five (25) laps will be the South Pacific Super Saloon Car Champion for 2019
